	Class	Guide	✓
1	Best overall garden	Most points gained in classes 2, 3 and 4. All who enter any classes 2, 3 or 4 will be automatically entered into class 1	
2	Front Garden – traditional summer bedding	A display of traditional summer bedding in a garden that is visible from a public street	
3	Front Garden – All Year round / theme garden	A garden comprising mainly of an all year round display	
4	Front Garden – Display of containers and/or hanging baskets	A display made up of a collection of hanging baskets and/or tubs and containers	
5	Individual Container	An individual container or hanging basket (will be selected by the judges). All who enter class 4 will be entered into class 5.	
6	Novice (2,3, 4 & 5)	The best entry in each of classes 2, 3, 4 and 5 where the entrant has not won a trophy in the last 5 years. All who enter any classes 2, 3 or 4 will be automatically entered into class 6	
8	Neighbourhood Area	A group of gardens in a close, cul de sac or street (Please attach a list of gardens entered).	
10	Public Area	Group or individual tending or caring for a public area
